Social incentives

Highlight what other people are doing. Compare behaviors.

Progress monitoring

Highlight the progress, not the decline.

Immediate reward

More valuable than reward we can get in the future. Gets associate to the action, which can become a habit.

Sense of control

Having the ability to influence the action, to make it evolve.

Insights

The process of learning a new language can lead to frustrations such as not having time to practice and seeing little to no progress.

Seeing progress in a concrete way helps people staying motivated, gaining confidence in their abilities and noticing that all their work is paying off.

People want to be guided through their learning journey, while having some options.

Interesting learning topics would encourage people to practice more, assimilate the vocabulary more easily and overall make the learning process more entertaining.


It would encourage me to learn in an active way and not only with lectures that encourage passive learning.
